You will be directed to the nearest agency

Agency requirements:

The agency requirements vary. You will need to
provide your 72-hour disconnect notice, proof
that you paid 25 percent of your outstanding
bill, proof of income and other information
requested by the agency.

Adams Electric requirements:

1. You will need to pay 25 percent of your
past-due balance at your nearest Adams
Electric office.
2. You will need to make satisfactory payment
arrangements for any unpaid bill amount.
3. You must enroll or be enrolled in the Round-
Up program.

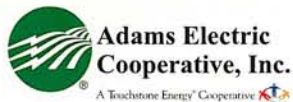

Your contributions to Project Helping Hand can help people like Donna and other members who face difficult times in life.

Members may have financial stress any time of year.

- Illness and job loss can happen to anyone, anytime.
- Winter and summer weather extremes can cause higher energy bills.
- Health-related costs are rising.

For 25 years, **Project Helping Hand** has been able to help keep the lights on for fellow members in need. On average, 250-300 members receive help through the program each year.

Nearly 5,000 of Adams Electric’s 31,000 members donate their change to Project Helping Hand through the Round-Up Program. Will you help your fellow co-op members in need by allowing the co-op to “Round-Up” your electric bills each month?

How Round-Up works. . .

- If your electric bill is \$85.36, you would pay \$86. Your bill would show that you are giving a \$.64 Round-Up contribution to Project Helping Hand.
- Your Round-Up donation and checks payable to Adams Electric’s Project Helping Hand Fund are **tax-deductible**.
- Your annual Round-Up donation will average \$6, may be as small as \$.12 and will never be more than \$11.88 per year. All donations go directly to help Adams Electric members.
- You may join the Round-Up program any time during the year by contacting the cooperative at 888/232-6732. You may cancel participation whenever you wish.

Other ways to donate to Project Helping Hand:

- Have a donation added to your bill one time per year
- Send a personal check
- Contribute your patronage capital money each year

For your tax records, your annual donation to Project Helping Hand through your electric bill is noted on your January and February bills each year. The total is for the previous year.
