Oversee elections

The **Credentials & Election Committee** is made up of 12 randomly selected member-volunteers. One member from each director zone is selected for the committee. A second committee member is also selected from the three zones where a board member is up for election that year.

The Election Committee supervises the process for electing directors. This includes acting as a nominating committee in the event that no petition is received from a zone where a director is to be elected.

Committee members fulfill their responsibilities by meeting in:

- Early February to validate candidate petitions.
- Mid-February, for a candidate meeting, if there is a contested election.
- March, at a member meeting, where a committee member gives a report to the members in their zone. If there is a contested election, the committee members from this zone will also collect ballots cast at the meeting.
- Late March to certify the primary election results, if there is a contested election.
- Late May or early June, typically right before the annual meeting, to certify mail-in and online ballots for the general election.
- Late May or early June, at the annual meeting, to collect and tally ballots cast in-person, and announce the winners of the election.

Members of the committee are reimbursed each calendar year for mileage to meetings attended. They also receive a small stipend.

The **Member Advisory Committee (MAC)** is made up of 27 member-volunteers (three from each director zone), and their spouses, who meet at least twice a year.

The committee acts in an advisory capacity to the board and management staff. A term is two calendar years, with a maximum service of three consecutive terms (total of six years).

MAC usually meets in the spring and fall. Meetings are planned to announce important information, test new ideas, introduce new technology, present changes in rates or policies and answer questions from the committee. An occasional field trip is also planned.

Members of the committee are reimbursed each calendar year for mileage to meetings attended.

Help pick winners

The **Scholarship Committee** is made up of nine member-volunteers. The committee selects winners of the co-op's high school and adult scholarship program.

Committee members fulfill their responsibilities by:

- Attending a spring organizational meeting.
- Attending two meetings to select scholarship winners.

Committee members must have a computer with a broadband Internet connection and a current email address.

Members of the committee are reimbursed each calendar year for mileage to meetings attended. A term is three years.
