Oversee elections

The **Credentials & Election Committee** is made up of 12 volunteers representing all nine of Adams Electric's director zones. One member from each zone is selected, as well as a second committee member for the three zones where a board member is up for election that year.

The Committee oversees the process of electing directors. This includes acting as a nominating committee in the event that no petition is received from a zone where a director is to be elected.

Committee members fulfill their responsibilities by:

- Attending an organizational meeting to validate candidate petitions.
- Attending a zone meeting. One committee member is selected to give an Election Committee report at each meeting. If there is a contested election in a zone, the committee members from that zone tally ballot position votes to determine which name will appear first for that zone on the general election ballot.
- Attending a meeting the day before the annual meeting to tally mail-in ballots.
- Attending the annual meeting. Committee members collect and tally the ballots cast in person and announce the winners of the election.

For each meeting attended, the members of the committee receive a small stipend and are reimbursed for mileage.

Hear it here first

The **Member Advisory Committee (MAC)** is made up of 27 volunteers (three from each director zone), and their spouses, who meet at least twice a year.

The committee acts in an advisory capacity to the board and management staff. A term is two calendar years, with a maximum service of three consecutive terms (total of six years).

MAC usually meets in the spring and fall. All meetings are planned and coordinated by the Communications/Community Services Department. Meetings are based on important issues or information, the need to test ideas, new technology, changes in rates or policies, and requests from the committee.

Members of the committee are reimbursed each calendar year for mileage to meetings attended.

Help pick winners

The **Scholarship Committee** is made up of nine members, one from each director zone. The committee meets at least twice in the spring to determine scholarship winners.

The committee selects winners of the Adams Electric Cooperative Scholarship from applicants not attending one of 17 public high schools which already award a co-op scholarship.

Committee members fulfill their responsibilities by:

- Attending an organizational meeting.
- Attending a meeting to select scholarship winners.

Members of the committee are reimbursed each calendar year for mileage to meetings attended.

A term is three years.
