

Recovering higher energy supply charges

The electric bills you receive from July through October will again include a summer energy charge (\$.022 per kwh) under the "ENERGY SUPPLY" section, reflecting your electricity use during the months of June through September. The charge is designed to recover the higher overall cost of energy supply* during those four months.

Beginning in 2008, the co-op could no longer absorb rising energy supply costs and needed to pass them along. Instead of levying a rate increase for the entire year, Adams Electric chose to recover those higher costs during the four months when they occur. For help with lowering your energy bills see the other side of this insert.

** The \$.083 per kwh you pay for energy supply during the summer months compares well with the \$.086 that First Energy Met-Ed customers pay for energy supply year round. Your energy supply costs drop to \$.061 per kwh for energy supply during the eight months of October through May.*

A summer energy charge will again appear on the bills you receive from July through October.

Are you saving where you can?

- **Load Control**--A load control receiver (LCR) on your electric water heater qualifies you for a \$5 bill credit.
- **Water Heater Rebate**--Receive a \$50 bill credit for allowing an LCR to be installed on an existing electric water heater. Receive up to a \$100 rebate for a new electric water heaters that has an LCR on it.
- **New Heating/Cooling Systems**--Install an electric thermal storage (ETS) unit or combine an air-source heat pump with ETS. Also consider a ground-source heat pump that offers higher efficiency.
- **Special Rates**--An interruptible rate provides a lower rate for all the electricity flowing through a separately metered subpanel. In addition, a time-of-day plan provides a lower rate for all electricity that you can

defer to off-peak hours (other than between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. weekdays).

- **Energy Audits**--Visit adamsec.coop and perform an online energy audit or arrange to sit down with someone from Adams Electric in your home or business.
- **Energy Loans**--Low interest loans are available to help you pay for a new preferred heating and cooling system or energy improvements to your home.
- **Online Information**--Visit adamsec.coop for helpful online energy calculators and lots of information to help you lower your energy bills.
