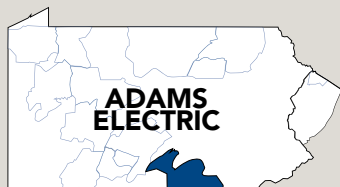

Volunteers are solicited year-round, and those who register are added to a mailing list. Those on the list receive a mailing once a year that includes a postcard that can be returned indicating your current interest and availability to serve on a committee for the coming year or term. Positions are

open on all committees each year, but the number of open seats can vary.

We currently have three active committees:

- ▶ Credentials and Election Committee (oversee the election process and certify ballots cast).
- ▶ Scholarship Committee (help review applications and recommend our scholarship winners — email and internet access required).
- ▶ Member Advisory Committee (hear our news first, serve as a sounding board for changes and help generate fresh ideas).

If you are interested in learning more about serving as a director, please visit adamsec.coop or read the story on page 12d of this issue about director positions up for election in 2021. A process is in place for interested members to become director candidates.

Want to volunteer? A sign-up form will be included with all mailed November bills, or you can sign up online at adamsec.coop under My Co-op, Be a Co-op Volunteer.

The names of those who have shown an interest in filling a vacant committee seat for the following year are placed into a random drawing. If there are unfilled seats, the communications department contacts those on the volunteer list until all seats are filled.

Whether it's inside our co-op headquarters or virtually, I hope to see you at a co-op committee meeting or another community board table in the new year. ☀

Strubs celebrate camping season despite challenges

DUE TO coronavirus, many people have replaced long-distance vacations with more local outdoor recreation, including camping. Adams Electric members Charlie and Lucille Strub, owners of Dogwood Acres Campground near Newville, Cumberland County, for 20 years, have this year experienced firsthand the surge as the facility wraps up 50 years of family camping.

The Strubs, originally from Long Island, N.Y., took a rustic camping area built by James and Doris Mentzer and expanded it into a facility that garnered a national “Park of the Year” award, the highest honor given to campgrounds and resorts. Dogwood Acres boasts 100 full hook-up sites, tent sites and three styles of cabins. Amenities include a swimming pool, playground, fishing pond, pedal cart rentals, hiking trails and a nine-hole disc golf course.

From 2001 to 2007, the Strubs operated the campground in partnership with cousins who hailed from Staten Island.

“In the early days, we would travel from New York every weekend — 250

miles — to help our cousins run the campground,” Lucille says. “It’s been an adventure. People have told us we should have written a book. Every year is a new chapter.”

“The place just grew on us,” Charlie says. “We thought we would be here maybe seven years, but we are now here to stay.”

The 2020 season may have been the Strubs’ most challenging chapter as coronavirus delayed the opening until May and brought an influx of new people with little-to-no experience in camping. The effort to contain the virus required the wearing of masks, social distancing, and more hand washing, and forced changes to many of the weekend activities and cancellation of the campground’s annual meals for charities.

“We had to look at how to change the activities and still keep the campers safe,” Lucille says.

Many families made do with their own activities.

“I saw more people playing catch with their children this year,” Charlie says.

Dogwood Acres has helped many

charities over the years with dinners, breakfasts, auctions, carnivals, recycling cans, and selling chicken corn soup, chili, and other food items. The campground has raised money for amyotrophic lateral sclerosis, breast cancer research, Wounded Warriors, Pennsylvania Council of Churches and local residents. One recipient was Newville resident Dillon Strouse, who overcame limitations of cerebral palsy in his work as a disc jockey. An all-day benefit for Strouse raised over \$10,000 and resulted in a new wheelchair.

Seasonal campers chose Ronald McDonald House Charities (RMHC) as the campground’s primary charity. RMHC offers free housing, food, and support to families with children who are in nearby hospitals for treatment. Their efforts have raised \$100,000 to date for RMHC in Hershey.

As the season closed at the end of October, the Strubs are thankful for a safe and healthy year.

“I am thankful people were able to come here and enjoy the outdoors and hold family gatherings,” Lucille says. ☀️

The results are in!

Adams' COVID-19 response gauged strong among members

ADAMS ELECTRIC members perceive the co-op's response to the COVID-19 pandemic as "above average" or "excellent," according to a recent survey of the membership conducted by the National Rural Electric Cooperative Association (NRECA).

In June, as Pennsylvania began to relax some of its COVID-19 restrictions, NRECA sent an email invitation to 1,500 Adams Electric members asking for participation in a survey related to the pandemic and the cooperative's response. Over 350 of those invitations were accepted and survey results submitted.

According to the respondents, members' satisfaction with Adams Electric Cooperative is excellent, which rates higher than other nearby electric cooperatives. There is strong agreement among members that Adams is a name they can always trust, and that the co-op looks out for the welfare of the community.

During the survey, members were asked to evaluate a series of attributes, keeping the cooperative's performance during the COVID-19 pandemic in mind. Ratings for all nine attributes on average were evaluated at or above the "excellent" rating. Adams is

evaluated highest for maintaining business continuity and service throughout the pandemic, followed closely by having the community's best interests at heart.

"The co-op always has the member's best interests at the heart of all our decisions," says CEO/General Manager Steve Rasmussen, "not only during times of crisis, like COVID-19.

These positive results were encouraging to see that what we are doing matters and makes an impact in cooperative members' lives."

Adams' performance during this time compares well to other companies, with almost all saying the co-op's performance was about the same or better than the local grocery store, local bank/credit union, and/or other utility companies. The co-op compares most favorably to local grocery stores, with 30% of responders saying Adams has performed better.



FAVORABLE RESULTS: Sixty-eight percent of Adams member respondents gave the co-op a "10" rating (scale of 1-10, 10 being the highest) when it comes to overall satisfaction; an additional 14% put the co-op at a nine.

Despite the overwhelmingly positive results, a few members were unaware of new programs and procedures the co-op has put in place to assist members during COVID-19, including payment support programs. If you are worried about paying your electric bill, please contact the co-op at 1-800-726-2324. A member services representative can review your account and discuss different options with you.

Here's just a few actions Adams has taken because of the pandemic:

- ▶ Returned a Special Member Credit totaling \$1 million to all members in May.
- ▶ Closed public offices and expanded phone hours through May, and in June, reopened the offices by appointment only.
- ▶ Canceled the in-person 2020 district meetings and annual meeting to abide by Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommendations for gatherings.
- ▶ Put programs in place for those who are struggling to stay current on their electric bill (call 1-800-726-2324 for more information). ☀

NOTES FROM AROUND YOUR COOPERATIVE

Interested in helping to lead your co-op?

DO YOU have time to read, travel, learn and apply yourself to a leadership position in your local community? Do you have what it takes to be a director of your local electric cooperative?

The time is now to get engaged in the director election process if you are a cooperative member in good standing, and reside in:

Zone 1 - ADAMS COUNTY – Townships of Cumberland, Freedom, Liberty, and Mount Joy; and the Borough of Carroll Valley.

Zone 5 - YORK COUNTY – Townships of Heidelberg, Jefferson, Manheim, North Codorus, Penn and West Manheim.

Zone 8 - CUMBERLAND COUNTY – Townships of Lower Mifflin, North Newton, Southampton and Upper Frankford.

Director candidates must meet all

membership qualifications as set forth in the co-op's bylaws. The membership will then elect one director each from director Zones 1, 5 and 8 to help direct the business of the cooperative for the next three years. Each candidate must complete a petition packet, including filling out a personal profile and statement of candidacy, among other requirements. Candidates must also secure signatures and addresses of at least 15 Adams Electric members on an official petition.

Candidate packets may be picked up at any office of Adams Electric beginning Dec. 1, 2020. All required paperwork must be "actually and physically received" at a co-op office before 5 p.m. Jan. 28, 2021.
